HILLTOP LIBRARY NEWS

City Council has received the recommendation from the Facility Advisory Committee that supports the Tacoma Library System's proposal to allocate funds for a new Hilltop Library. We don't expect to hear from City Council regarding their decision on a new library until Spring.

A new library will require a possible bond issue and, if so, a city-wide vote in an upcoming election. We are waiting to hear which election may be the primary target so we can rally support. Stay tuned!
