HILLTOP LIBRARY NEWS

City Council presented the biennial budget for 2025–2026 at their Oct. 1st study session. You can find the PDF presentation here.



How library advocates can respond:

Nov. 19th is the proposed budget's

first public hearing and first reading (p.28) in council. There will also be additional community presentations and outreach with chances for comment. Adoption of a budget is currently scheduled for Dec. 3rd (p. 28), so be sure to speak your mind before then. Check out notices of public hearings here. Public written comments can be submitted before a meeting here. Sign up for the city's news emails here. Be sure you get your representative's emails as well. We'll do our best to keep you informed too!

Comment suggestions: Making library services in the Hilltop and Eastside a priority will support their current agenda. Remind City Council that libraries play key roles in helping the unhoused attain resources (p.22), as community safe spaces for children and adults (p.23) provide resources for job seekers and small businesses (p.25), and are necessary in neglected neighborhoods like Hilltop and Eastside if the city is truly dedicated to "Fostering a Diverse, Equitable and inclusive Culture." (p.27) And please thank them for adding a maker space librarian to the Access budget. (p. 24)
